What is a Take-Apart Day?

It is a day to explore how inventions are made. Students will bring a toy to take apart and see how it works. They will share with their peers and explore new ways to put the toys back together by themselves or with a friend to create a new toy. This is also their opportunity to find out about our Invention Convention Club and determine if it is the right activity for them.

What is the Invention Convention Club?

It is an after school club that meets on Wednesdays from January 18th through March 15th. Students are expected to create an invention at home. Activities at club meetings will help to support the process. A journal will need to be filled out marking their progress. On the 22nd of March our VVPS Invention Convention will be held. The young inventor will display their invention with a tri-fold presentation board explaining their process and the value of their invention. Judges will determine winner(s) who will in turn go to the regional level Invention Convention on April 1st at UConn.
