The 2017 Science Connecticut Mastery Test (CMT) will be administered to all students in grade five on April 4th. This test assesses the knowledge and skills identified in the science standards for grades 3-5. The Science test is approximately 75 minutes.

Throughout the school year, our teachers work hard to provide learning opportunities that are designed to develop each student's skill level and content knowledge in the area of science. Students in our fifth grade had the opportunity to revisit previously learned science information. Additionally, students will be able to complete a short practice test prior to the administration of the Science CMT to become familiar with the test format.

The CMT provides an excellent opportunity for students to demonstrate what they know and are able to do in the area of science. Your child needs to be relaxed, alert and capable of giving his/her full attention to the test. As always, a good night's sleep and a nutritious breakfast will help your child be successful. I ask you to encourage your child to take the test seriously and give it his/her best effort.
