



Washington Primary School's Walk for Water

Did you know:

1 in 9 people in the world do not have access to safe drinking water?

1 in 3 people do not have access to proper sanitation?

A person needs just 2-5 gallons of water a day for sanitation and drinking; but the average American uses 80 gallons of water a day!

Dear Families,

These are just some of the facts Washington Primary School students are learning as they study the water crisis in preparation for a Water Run being held on Friday, April 27th.

This simulation is great exercise and a way for each child to imagine what it is like for children who must carry up to five gallons of water (40lbs) 2-3 miles a day from shared community spickets to their homes or schools. Imagine if each morning students had to carry the 80 gallons (640lbs) of water Americans use!

Washington Primary School has established a goal of raising \$4125! With the help of H2OforLife and Global Water Challenge, two organizations that connect American schools with schools in need, the money we raise will help the 500 students at EZ Kabane High School in Port Elizabeth, South Africa. They currently only have one working toilet and one outdoor spicket for drinking water. There is another school in Alexandria Virginia also raising money for EZ Kabane so our goal is to raise just half of the \$8250 needed.
